The Village of Manotick

The Village of Manotick, now part of the City of Ottawa, is a twenty minute drive south of the center of the City. The Rideau Canal system of locks and waterways on the Rideau River running through the Village has recently been designated a World Heritage Site.

The Village of Manotick, once home to Canadian Group of Seven artist, A. Y. Jackson, features the Watson's Mill, still operating during the summer season, Dickinson House and other historic sites that make it a yearly tourist attraction. There are numerous parks, restaurants and shopping opportunities to be discovered as well.
